

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

Digital Visibility and Networks for Swiss Literature

The Swiss Arts Council Pro Helvetia awards project grants worth CHF 5,000 to CHF 10,000 for the implementation of digital projects serving to enhance the national or international visibility and dissemination of contemporary Swiss literature or the networking of the Swiss literary scene (e.g. online reading series, networking platforms/networking events, podcasts, book trailers).

Who may apply:

- Swiss authors and translators
- Literary event organisers
- Publishers of fiction and literary journals
- Professional associations in the field of literature

Funding is available, amongst others, for:

- Conception of dissemination or networking projects
- Costs of professional technical implementation
- Author and translator fees and, if necessary, international travel expenses

Projects must be carried out according to professional standards as regards form and content and seek to achieve national or international reach.

No funding is available for

Projects and events part of the international book fairs of Bologna, Frankfurt, Montréal, Paris, Rome, Turin, and Vienna. Swiss festivals already funded by Pro Helvetia may apply via this channel solely for additional digital focus programmes organised outside the festival. Excluded are furthermore website renewals or creations.

No funding is available for projects or sub-projects supported by another federal body.

Projects must be realised within 6 months. Applications may be submitted ongoing until 30 November 2021. Applications must be submitted via www.myprohelvetia.ch no later than 8 weeks prior to project commencement.
